

## Xenon bulb installation for the C6

---

### TOOLS NEEDED:

Flathead screwdriver (medium)

Torx T-15 on Z06 model

Jack, tire iron, jack stand (if you are removing the wheel)

1. Turn your front wheels completely to the left and begin with the passenger side fog light.
2. On the Z06 there are five T-15 torx screws, on the other model C6's there are about the same number of plastic 'push plugs'. Remove these. The push-plugs simply require you to remove them with a flat-head by prying the center plug up from the surrounding base. It's OK to remove the plug from the base. Sometimes it's easier just to remove the plug, then carefully slide your flat-head behind the base to get it out.
3. Once all the fasteners on the outer edge have been removed you should be able to pull the liner back enough to see your fog light. If you have big hands / arms you may need to remove one or two of the three inner push-plugs (shown here in aqua color).



4. If you still have a hard time reaching the fog light, you may be best to lift the car, remove the wheel, and remove all the fasteners shown above. This is the most easily accessible way to reach the bulb, but if you can reach it without removing the wheel you should be done with both sides in minutes.
5. Next unplug the harness from the bulb:



6. Twist the bulb counter-clockwise 1/8<sup>th</sup> turn and you can remove it by pulling it straight out:



7. Now just install the new Xenon bulb in the reverse order. **DO NOT TOUCH THE GLASS ON THE BULB!** If you do, you will need to wipe it off with rubbing alcohol to remove the oils from your finger.
  
8. Before reinstalling the hardware on your wheel well liner, turn the ignition on and check your fog lights to make sure it is working. Don't leave it on too long, as you will have a hot bulb to deal with on the other side's install!
  
9. Repeat the process on the driver's side after turning the wheels all the way to the right and **YOU'RE DONE!**
  
10. Enjoy the new modern look of your foglights! 😊
